



The MZTO-01 is designed for the 2007-2009 Mazda CX-7 and the 2007-2010 Mazda CX-9 with the Bose amplified sound system. Full balance and fading is retained along with a service connector so the clock on the display can be changed.

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

TOOLS REQUIRED FOR INSTALLATION

• Cutting Tool • Small Blade Screwdriver • Tape • Crimping Tool • Connectors (I.E. butt-connectors, bell caps, etc...)

<u>NOTE:</u> The vehicle must be <u>OFF</u> before plugging in the MZTO-01. Also after the MZTO-01 has been installed, you must turn the ignition key on for 10 seconds then back off for the MZTO-01 to be initialized.

WIRING THE MZTO-01

<u>*Important:</u> Before beginning any of the following, disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit.

<u>CONNECTIONS TO BE MADE ON THE RADIO SIDE</u> HARNESS:

- 1. Connect the **Blue/White** wire to the radios amplifier turn on wire and to the **Blue/White** wire from the Car side harness.
- $\ensuremath{\textbf{2}}.$ Plug the the $\ensuremath{\textbf{White}}$ RCA into the radios Left Front RCA output.
- 3. Plug the the Gray RCA into the radios Right Front RCA output.
- **4.** Plug the **Green** RCA into the radios Left Rear RCA output.
- 5. Plug the the Purple RCA into the radios Right Rear RCA output.

<u>CONNECTIONS TO BE MADE ON THE CAR SIDE</u> HARNESS:

- 1. Connect the Yellow wire to the radios 12 volt constant/memory wire.
- 2. Connect the Red wire to the radios 12 volt accessory wire.
- 3. Connect the **Black** wire to the radios ground wire.
- 4. Connect the **Blue/White** wire to the radios amplifier turn on wire and to the **Blue/White** wire from the Radio side harness.
- Connect the Blue wire to the radios antenna turn on wire. If the radio does not have that wire, connect the Blue wire to the Blue/White wire.
- 6. Connect the **Orange** wire to the radios Illumination wire. If your radio does not have an illumination wire, just tape off the wire.
- The Green/White wire is the steering wheel control wire. An aftermarket steering wheel control interface is needed to retain the use of the steering wheel controls.

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INSTALLING THE MZTO-01

- 1. With all connections made, plug the harnesses into the MZTO-01 interface then into the vehicle.
- 2. Turn the ignition on for about 10 seconds then turn off.

TESTING THE MZTO-01

1. Turn the radio on then balance left to right and fade from front to back to verify that the RCA's have been connected correctly.

AUDIO LEVEL CONTROL

Aftermarket radios have varying rca output voltages, some are high output, and some are low. So to fix this there is an audio input adjustment which can adjust the input voltage to the amplifier to provide the best signal possible. Follow the steps below to adjust the audio level:

- 1) Locate the level adjustment potentiometer on the side of the interface with the 14 way Molex connector.
- 2) Using a small Flat head screwdriver, turn the potentiometer counter clockwise to reduce the input signal (for radios with hi volt pre-outs).
- 3) Turn the potentiometer clockwise to increase the input signal (for radios with low volt pre-outs).
- **4)** Turn the radio to 3/4 volume and listen. If there is distortion heard then the potentiometer needs to be turned down.

SERVICE HARNESS

If need be, the clock on the display can be changed by connecting the OEM radio to the service harness on the MZTO-01. Once the clock has been changed, unplug the OEM radio and tuck the service harness back in the dash.
