





Attention! Let the vehicle sit with the key out of the ignition for a few minutes before removing the factory radio. When testing the aftermarket equipment, ensure that all factory equipment is connected before cycling the key to ignition.

DASH DISASSEMBLY

KIT PREPARATION


- **1.** Unclip and remove the lower trim panel.
- **2.** Unclip and remove the a/c vent trim panel.
- Remove (2) screws securing the radio/ climate control panel, then unplug and remove the panel.
- **4.** Remove (4) screws securing the radio, then unplug and remove the radio.
- Remove (2) screws securing the radio display screen, then unplug and remove the screen.

- 1. Remove (2) screws securing the climate controls to the radio/climate control panel, then remove the climate controls.
- **2.** Secure the climate controls to the *radio trim panel* using the factory screws. (Figure A)
- **3.** Remove (2) clips from the radio/climate control panel, then attach them onto the *radio trim panel*.



KIT ASSEMBLY

ISO DDIN radio provision

- Secure the radio brackets to the radio using the screws provided with the radio. (Figure A)
 - **Note:** Screws have been provided only if the radio did not come with screws.
- 2. Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna connection in the dash, and complete all necessary connections to the radio. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra and/or Axxess. Test the radio for proper operation.

- **3.** Secure the completed assembly to the dash using the factory screws.
- Attach the ISO DDIN trim to the radio trim panel, and then reassemble the dash in reverse order of disassembly.
- **5.** Snap the *display panel cover* in place of the radio display.
- **6.** Using double sided tape (not provided), attach the *rubber mat* onto the shelf on the bottom edge of the *display panel cover* to complete the installation.
